SCHOLARSHIP AND AWARD TYPES

A. <u>FUTURE EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP</u>

This award is given as a tribute to one component of our Five-Point Programmatic Thrust, Education. It is also in recognition of Delta's membership, consisting of educated women. Qualifying students must plan to major in **Education** and have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities in the community and their school.

B. DR. BETTY SHABAZZ SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given in honor of Dr. Betty Shabazz, a notable member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated. Dr. Betty Shabazz was an influential activist, civil rights leader who dedicated her life to championing women's and children's rights. As a registered nurse, Dr. Betty Shabazz went on to later earn her masters in public health and doctorate in education administration. In support of increasing diversity in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), qualifying students must plan to major in a **STEM** field and have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities in the community and their school.

C. GILDA LEWIS PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Gilda Lewis was a charter member and a past president of the Columbia (MD) Alumnae Chapter. The Chapter honors this educator who dedicated her life to public service. With a commitment to public service, qualifying students must have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities in the community and their school, and plan to continue their post-secondary education.

D. CELONIA B. WALDEN PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given in honor of Celonia B. Walden, a charter member and past president of the Columbia (MD) Alumnae Chapter. Qualifying students must plan to major in any facet of **Expressive or Performing Arts** and have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities in the community and their school.
